Eligibility: All selected teams from Stage 2 competitions. There will not be any provision for spares. Additional cadets wishing to participate in some capacity should make themselves available as support cadets ASAP.

Corps / Squadrons which do not have .22 cal LR biathlon rifles for competition must identify in advance to arrange access for rifles. Alibis for shared rifles will not be offered for this provincial competition.

Commanding Officers and coaches of participating corps / squadrons are to ensure rifles used in the provincial competitions must be zeroed to their respective cadets at 50m and sized prior to the competition date.

Rules: Cadets Canada Biathlon Competition Rules and IBU/Cadets Disciplinary Rules as modified by the Organizing Committee will be in effect.

For this Stage 3 competition, a penalty loop shall be skied for each target left standing after all rounds for the bout have been fired.

Competitor categories are per the Common Training Joining Instructions:

Junior – a cadet who has not reached his/her 15th birthday on or before the final day of the National Cadet Biathlon Championship (Including travel days) which this year is 10 March 2020;

Senior - a cadet who has not reached his/her 17th birthday on or before the final day of the National Cadet Biathlon Championship (Including travel days) which this year is 10 March 2020; and

Youth Men and Women - Cadets 17 and 18 years old on or before the final day of the National Cadet Biathlon Championship (Including travel days) which this year is 10 March 2020

Start: Simultaneous and Tag

Range: 5 targets plus 3 spare rounds per shooting bout
150m penalty loop
